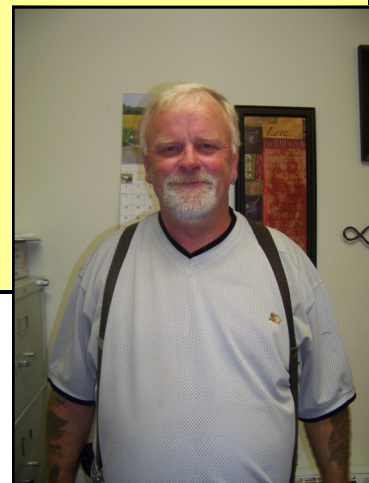

## RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

WESCO's residential programs are designed to promote independence for individuals with physical and mental disabilities. WESCO's support staff provides training and supervision which enables those served to live as independently as possible in their own homes or in a group living home.

WESCO provides residential services to 13 individuals in an RCF/MR facility located in Denison. This facility is licensed through the Department of Inspections and Appeals. Services encompass complete room and board as well as daily living skills. Emphasis is placed on teaching a variety of life skills depending on the needs of each individual as well as providing training to assist residents in reaching their potential to become as independent as possible.

The 24 hour Supported Community Living Program is to assist individuals to living in their own homes with peers. These individuals receive training to maintain and improve their

skills as well as overall supervision for safety.

The non24 hour Supported Community Living Program is designed to assist individuals who live in their own homes with specific skill needs. These individuals do not need overall supervision.
